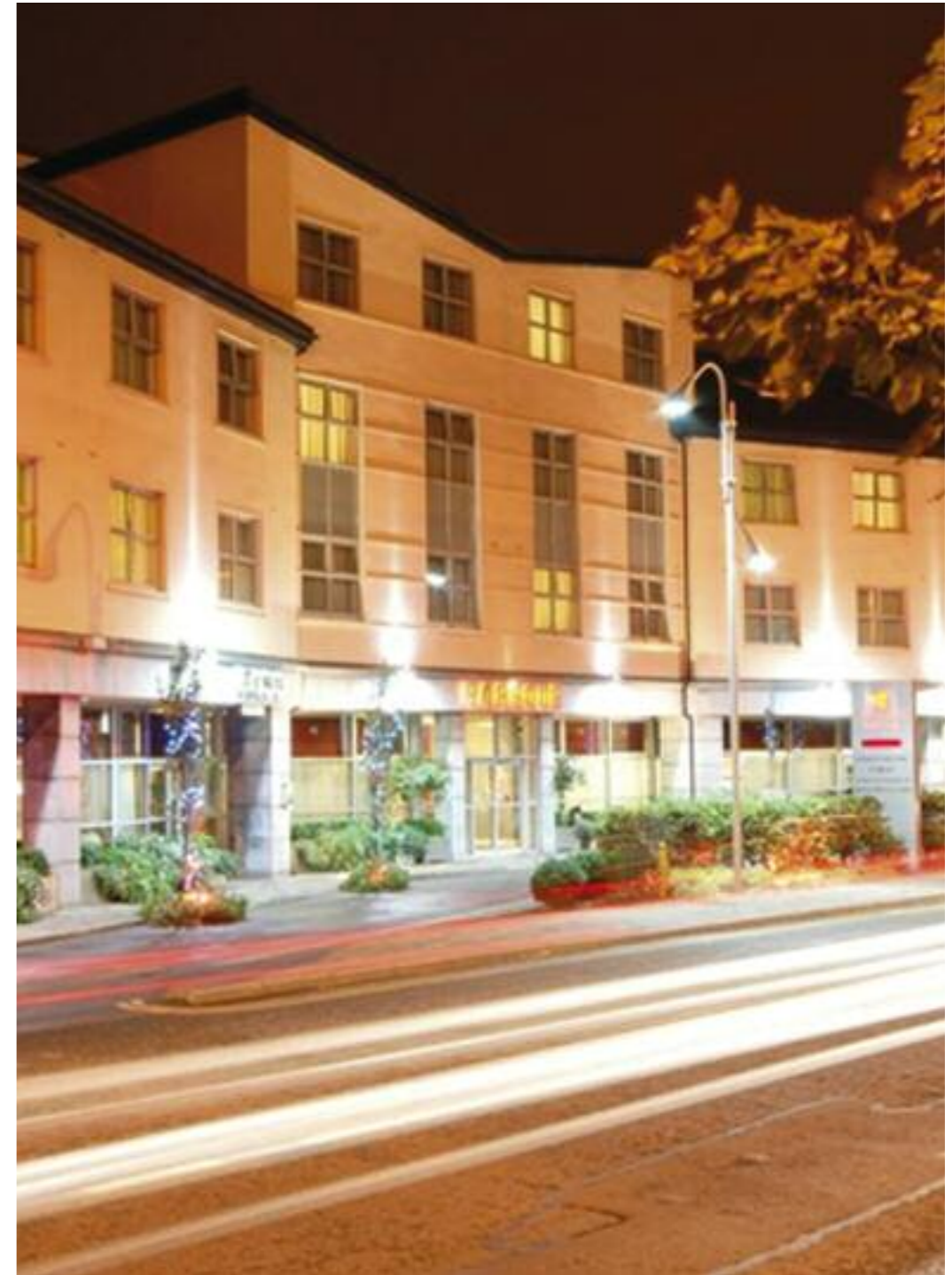


## Activities

With spectacular views over Dublin city, the Hilton Kilmainham is an oasis in the heart of Dublin.

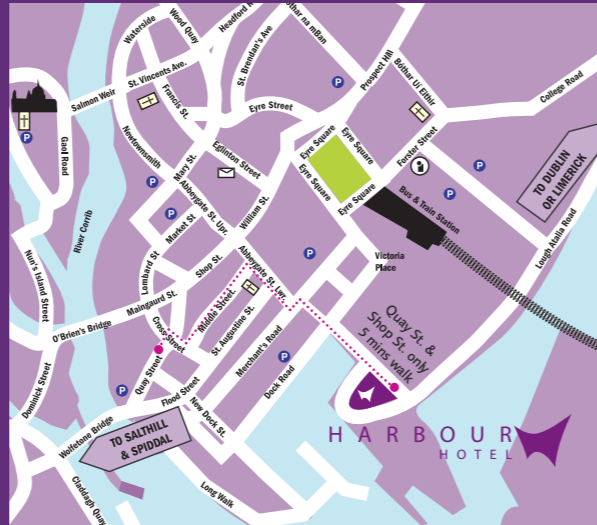


### Limerick Strand Hotel
